MEETING CRITICAL NEEDS

Our members deliver the evidence-based treatment that the research shows reduces recidivism and gets criminal justice-involved individuals back on track to live law-abiding, productive lives. Our commitment is to assess the needs of **EVERY** person entering our facilities and provide an effective, individualized package of treatment and programming that contributes to public safety in our communities. Services include:

- ◆ **Substance Use Disorder Services** (Chemical dependency treatment, aftercare/relapse prevention, self help groups, prevention, drug & alcohol testing)
- ◆ **Cognitive Skills** (Criminal thinking, “Thinking for a Change,” restorative justice, victim impact, anger management, family/parenting)
- ◆ **Education Services** (Literacy/tutoring, Adult Basic Education (ABE), General Equivalency Diploma (GED) prep and testing, vocational services, computer training, certification programs)
- ◆ **Employment Services** (Job readiness, jobs assistance/placement/retention, certification programs)
- ◆ **Special Services and Populations** (Mental health, sex offender treatment, developmentally disabled, dual diagnosis treatment, domestic violence services, veteran services, geriatric services, human trafficking victims, children/family programs)

Ohio. These facilities are critical components of our criminal justice system as they provide both a residential reentry option for those leaving prison and an alternative to divert individuals from prison or jail.

SERVING OHIO ONE LIFE AT A TIME



Halfway houses **served 8145 individuals** in FY24, providing needed housing, programming, and treatment.

WORKFORCE PARTICIPATION



Halfway house residents found gainful employment and **earned almost \$9 million** in FY24.

TAX PAYING CITIZENS



Halfway house residents paid an estimated **\$878,153 in taxes** in FY24.

SERVING COMMUNITIES



Halfway house residents provided **66,992 hours** of community service across Ohio in FY24.

TAKING ACCOUNTABILITY



When HWH residents secure employment, they pay child support and court fines/fees, make restitution to victims, and contribute toward the cost of their HWH stay.
